STATE DIRECTOR

I hope everyone is healthy and doing well. This has been a very busy year and it seems that everything has worked out great. We have a good relationship with the Department, we were the 2nd highest donor for the Miracle Ride, had a great turnout for the closing of the books, a great time at the State Rally, and the National Romp. I would like to thank the Riley Chapter for the Rally and the Jasper Chapter for the Romp. A lot of hard work for a Job well done by both.

We need to think about election of officers for 2012, happening at the October Conference. Voting will be done by written ballot, with each chapter still getting 1 vote for every 10 members plus 1 at large and 1 Director vote, if the Chapter Director is present. The ballots will be counted by the first 3 district committee representatives, who are present, as district numbers are drawn using a blind draw. The State Sgt-At-Arms (Corey Moore) will oversee the ballot counting. The specifics as to how the ballot voting will be conducted will be determined at the state officer meeting, prior to the conference. We will also determine if there will be a recess after nominations are closed or if we will just move on with the meeting. Due to it being individual voting we may not need a recess.

Another item for the October Conference, is who do we want to make donations to, why, and how much. At this time we have an unspecified amount of money to donate. Dina will have that figure at the meeting.

The bylaw amendments voted on at the July meeting will be reviewed by the Department Executive Committee at the October Conference. Once they are approved, the bylaws will be updated on the website to reflect those changes. The bylaw amendments made will put us in line with Resolution 32, which was just passed May 4-5, 2011. Resolution 32 is an amendment to Resolution 35 and it is very clear what the membership requirements are.
